

#### **ROAD SAFETY REMINDER**

Following our recent communication on road safety, the HOA continues to receive complaints and concerns from residents, and we strongly urge all road users to adhere to the rules.

#### General Road Safety:

- The Estate speed limit of 40 km/h applies at all times.
- Helmets are mandatory for all riders of bicycles, scooters, stand-up scooters, and motorbikes. No helmet – no ride.
- Night riding requires safety lighting: a front-facing light and rear reflectors are the minimum requirement.
- All road signs and markings must be obeyed, including stop streets and yield signs.
- Reckless or negligent behaviour is strictly prohibited, including riding on the wrong side of the road, cutting traffic circles, or any other unsafe actions.

#### Safety Around Building Sites:

Several construction projects are currently underway across the Estate, particularly along Bear Creek Boulevard and Valhalla Circle, Shoal Creek Crescent, and throughout The Acres. These areas see frequent movement of large trucks and delivery vehicles, and we ask residents to take extra care when passing through:

- Large trucks may temporarily block sections of the road while offloading materials.
- While disruptions are kept to a minimum, please approach these areas with patience and caution.
- Limited parking may require some contractors to park on verges for short periods.
- Contractors are strictly prohibited from parking in residents' driveways or obstructing access to neighbouring properties.

#### PREVENTION OF SNAKE BITES

Please note that we are currently in the peak season for snake activity on the Estate, and several sightings have been reported this week. We therefore ask residents to remain extra vigilant:

Here are some important safety measures provided by the *African Snakebite Institute* (ASI) to keep in mind:

- Leave snakes alone and treat them with respect at all times.
- Do not handle snakes, even small ones. Juvenile venomous snakes are just as dangerous as the adults.
- Never tamper with a seemingly dead snake, as many have the nasty habit of playing dead when scared or threatened, only to strike out the moment an opportunity arises.
- Wear boots and thick trousers or jeans if you spend a great deal of time outdoors.
   Hunters, hikers, birders and fishermen should consider wearing snake gaiters that protect the lower leg.
- Step onto logs and rocks and never over them. Snakes often sun themselves while partially concealed under a log or rock.
- Never put your hands in out-of- sight places, especially when mountain climbing. Berg Adders are known to bask on small ledges and will certainly bite if a hand suddenly appears close by.
- Never walk barefoot or without a torch at night when camping or visiting facilities in the bush. Many snakes are active after sunset, and slow-moving snakes like the Puff Adder are easily trodden on.
- Do not try to kill or catch a snake if you come across one. Throwing rocks or shooting at a snake is looking for trouble. Also do not attempt to catch a snake with braai tongs or pin it and grab it behind the head. Some snakes, such as the Stiletto Snake, cannot be held safely behind the head and you will certainly get bitten if you try.

Please remember to immediately call the Security Team at 021 867 1201 if you encounter a snake anywhere on the Estate. Trained responders will safely catch and relocate the snake.

#### **PVHOA Facilities & Services:**

- **PVHOA Office:** Closing on Friday, 19 December 2025 at 13:00 and reopening on Monday, 5 January 2026 at 08:00.

  and public holidays.

During the shutdown period, no building activities or contractor companies are permitted on the Estate, except for emergency repairs (e.g. burst geysers, plumbing, electrical, or internet failures).
- Domestic garden service operators and pool cleaning services may continue their regular
  maintenance and upkeep activities. However, no garden or pool service providers will be
  permitted to work on the Estate between Christmas and New Year. Courier services and
  home delivery services will operate as usual throughout the holiday period. Residents are
  kindly requested to make a note of these dates and plan ahead accordingly.

- Christmas Eve: Open from 07:00 15:00

- The swimming pool is closed on Christmas Day.


#### **Pearl Valley Gym:**
