## UPDATE: WATER PRESSURE PROBLEMS

Drakenstein Municipality is continuing with intermittent maintenance on the main water line to the Estate in an effort to resolve the ongoing low pressure problem. The HOA is monitoring water pressure every day and remains in constant contact with Drakenstein officials to provide regular feedback.

We have also noted that the low water pressure experienced in certain areas of the Estate during peak periods (particularly between 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM) may be worsened by the fact that many residents run their irrigation systems early in the morning - and for extended periods due to the summer heat. This, combined with the normal increase in household water usage as residents begin their day, results in a significant spike in demand each morning.

We therefore encourage residents to consider adjusting the times at which they run their irrigation systems to avoid peak periods. Whilst we emphasise that irrigation systems are not the cause of the current issues with the Drakenstein supply, any steps we can take as a community to help reduce the impact during this period will be beneficial.

## FESTIVE SEASON REFUSE & RECYCLING COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Drakenstein Municipality has confirmed that household refuse and recycling collections will continue as normal over the festive season. Recycling will still be collected by Drakenstein Municipality on Wednesdays.

Please ensure that bins are placed outside before 08:00 on the day of collection and brought back inside the property on the same day.


As a general reminder, if residents are away during any week, household refuse (in sealed plastic bags) may be disposed of in one of the open skips at the recycling facility at the Pearl Valley Main Gate. Please note that the facility is primarily designated for recyclable materials (glass, plastic, and paper) and is not intended for general household waste. Kindly use the appropriately labelled bins to sort all recyclables.


### REMINDER: NEW EMERGENCY NUMBER FOR AMBULANCE SERVICE

### FESTIVE SEASON OPERATING TIMES

#### PVHOA Facilities & Services:

- **PVHOA Office:** Closing on Friday, 19 December 2025 at 13:00 and reopening on Monday, 5 January 2026 at 08:00.

- **Pearl Valley Enrolment Centre (at Main Gate):** The Centre will remain open during the festive season to assist residents, but will be closed on weekends and public holidays.
- **Shuttle Bus Service:** Operational until Friday, 19 December 2025. The service will resume on Monday, 5 January 2026, at 07:15.
- HOA Office Staff will hold its annual year-end function on Friday, 12 December 2025, from 13:00.
- HOA Maintenance Staff will hold its annual year-end function on Monday, 15 December 2025, from 13:00.

**Green Waste Site on Watervliet Farm:**

- Facility Hours: Open Monday to Friday from 08:30 to 16:30, and on Saturdays from 08:30 to 13:00. Closed on Sundays and public holidays.

Please note that during the Christmas and New Year period, only residents are permitted to drop off waste, as no service providers are allowed on the Estate at that time.

**Annual Contractor Shutdown:**

- The annual construction industry shutdown will run between Friday, 12 December 2025 and Monday, 12 January 2026. During the shutdown period, no building activities or contractor companies are permitted on the Estate, except for emergency repairs (e.g. burst geysers, plumbing, electrical, or internet failures).
- Domestic garden service operators and pool cleaning services may continue their regular maintenance and upkeep activities. However, no garden or pool service providers will be permitted to work on the Estate between Christmas and New Year. Courier services and home delivery services will operate as usual throughout the holiday period. Residents are kindly requested to make a note of these dates and plan ahead accordingly.

- Christmas Eve: Open from 07:00 – 15:00
- Christmas Day: Open for breakfast from 07:30 - 09:30; Christmas lunch from 12:00 - 15:00 (Bookings only)

**Pearl Valley Golf:**

- Pearl Valley Golf Shop: Mondays – Sundays: 06:30 – 18:30.
- Pearl Valley Golf Course: Mondays – Sundays: 07:30 – 19:00.
- Pearl Valley Driving Range: Mondays – Sundays: Open from 07:00; last ball at 17:30. Range closes at 18:00.
- The golf shop, golf course and driving range are closed on Christmas Day.
